

**Area 1 – El Prado West Exhibits**  
Exhibits are on the grass on the north and south sides of El Prado. No electricity

**Area 2 – El Prado East Exhibits**  
Exhibit space is on the lawn. The parade passes through this area in the morning. No electricity.

**Area 3 – Children's Area**  
Exhibits must address children or children's issues. Special preference to educational and hands-on activities for kids.

**Area 10 – Plaza de Panama Exhibits**  
Exhibits are in groups around the area and the fountain. Concrete surface. Electricity available in north exhibit area. Food service in northeast corner.

**Area 4 – Mall Exhibits**  
Exhibits are on the grass on the east side of the mall, just west of the Japanese Tea Garden. No electricity.

**Area 6 – UN Lawn Exhibits**  
Exhibits on the lawn in front of the UN Building and House of Pacific Relations. Because of some shade from trees, preference will be given to exhibits with live animals.

**Area R – Reuse & Repair**  
Exhibits related to reuse and repair of used items. Exhibit space is on the lawn, among palm trees.

**Area 7 – Pan American Plaza Exhibits**  
Area includes the eHome and Cleaner Car Concourse. Exhibits on asphalt parking lot. Electricity available.

**Area 8 – Federal Bldg. Exhibits**  
Exhibits are on the lawn on the northeast side of the Federal Building. No electricity.

**Area 9 – Earth-friendly Food Court**  
One of two food courts. Booths are on the lawn. Electricity available.

**eARTH Gallery – Eco Arts & Crafts**
